

XCEL ENERGY CENTER ARENA COMPLEX RENOVATION PROJECT



PROJECT SUMMARY

The Xcel Energy Center Arena Complexcomprised of the Xcel Energy Center Arena, Roy Wilkins Auditorium, and Saint Paul RiverCentre-stands as the most prolific driver of economic activity in Saint Paul. Each year, the Arena Complex attracts over 2.1 million visitors and brings in \$383 million in spending annually for the City of Saint Paul. Last year, the complex hosted nearly 400 events.

Now in its 25th year of its 25-year lifespan, a renovation is required to preserve the cityowned facility and maintain its status as an exceptional local and statewide destination. If funded, construction on the multi-phase renovation project could begin as early as 2026.

OUR OPPORTUNITY

Total Project Cost: \$769 million

Proposed Funding Breakdown:

State of Minnesota – \$394.6M (50%) Minnesota Wild – \$215.8M (30%) Saint Paul and Local Partners – \$158.8M (20%) The Xcel Energy Center Arena Complex has not undergone any major renovations or updates since 2014 when the mid-ice screen and stadium seats were replaced.

THIS IS WHAT TRANSFORMATION LOOKS LIKE

A renovated complex is anticipated to **boost downtown spending** to an estimated \$493 million a year, with the renovation project creating approximately **2,300 union construction jobs.** When complete, it will **employ more than 5,000 people** in Saint Paul.

This transformative project will build capacity for further reinvestment in our downtown, essential for rebounding post-pandemic. We have the opportunity to create a more competitive entertainment district to attract more events.

A REGIONAL AND STATEWIDE ASSET

The Arena Complex project is a catalyst for economic growth and development, driving tourism and generating revenue for local businesses. Throughout the year, the Arena Complex hosts:

- Minnesota Wild and Minnesota Frost professional hockey teams
- Nationally touring concerts and performances
- Cultural events, citizenship ceremonies, and graduations
- State High School League athletic tournaments
- Exhibitions and trade shows
